# TASK FORCE ON TRUCKING HARMONIZATION

# Objective

1. To provide a progress update on the work of the Task Force.

# Background

- Despite significant advancements towards harmonizing trucking standards across Canada, the trucking industry has continued to express concerns about regulatory differences among between provinces including during Transportation 2030 consultations.
- As a result, in September 2016, the Transportation Ministers agreed to establish a new federal/provincial/territorial task force to study interprovincial truck-related regulations.
- The Task Force was formed in January 2017 and is co-chaired by Transport Canada and Saskatchewan, with representation from all provinces and territories.

# Mandate

To investigate whether more can be done to improve the efficiency of the trucking industry and identify areas that would benefit from increased harmonization.

### Terms of Reference – Work Plan

- The Task Force will take a strategic approach to interprovincial trade by truck and conduct its work in three phases:
  - *Phase 1* will identify key issues that are perceived to be irritants or barriers to the trucking industry.
    - o This phase also includes stakeholder consultations
    - Planned completion Spring 2018 meeting of the Council of Deputy Ministers
  - > Phase 2 will examine the root cause of each issue and identify potential solutions.
    - Planned Completion Fall 2018 meeting of the Council of Ministers
  - Phase 3 will further analyze potential solutions and assess the likelihood of harmonization success for each issue, in the short- and the long-term.
    - The final report will include identification of barriers/irritants to the interprovincial movement of trucks and recommended actions, if any, to address them, which can be dealt with in the short or long-term.
    - Planned Completion Fall 2019 meeting of the Council of Ministers

# **Progress Update:**

- Since its formation, the Task Force has been meeting biweekly. All jurisdictions are working cooperatively and sharing the workload.
- The Task Force is currently compiling an inventory of trucking harmonization issues (Phase 1) and:
  - > In the process of compiling the results from the literature review of relevant reports.
  - Have reached out to key stakeholders and associations to seek their input. (December 15, 2017)
  - Created an online survey for industry stakeholders to provide their input.
