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# Regulatory/Permitting Update

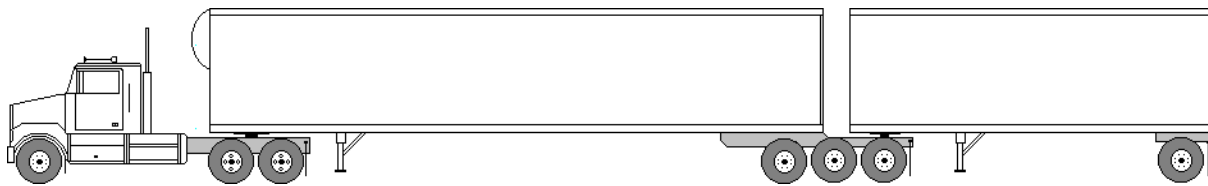
- Regulatory amendments to NB *Vehicle Dimensions and Mass Regulation* (Reg. 2001-67). Current to 2019 VW&D MoU.
- Wide Base Single Tires – Eligible to operate at parity with dual tire assemblies via permit.
- Updating over dimensional/over mass policy.

# Infrastructure Update

- Infrastructure Upgrades – Arterial and Collector Highways:
  - Centennial Bridge (Phase 3/4) - Route 8/Route 11
  - Coles Island Bridges - Route 10.
  - Florenceville Bridge (Phase 3/4) – Route 130
  - Anderson Bridge - Route 8.
  - Petitcodiac River Bridge (Phase 3) – Route 114.
  - Edmundston/Madawaska International Bridge – Route 120/Route 144

# Long Combination Vehicles Update

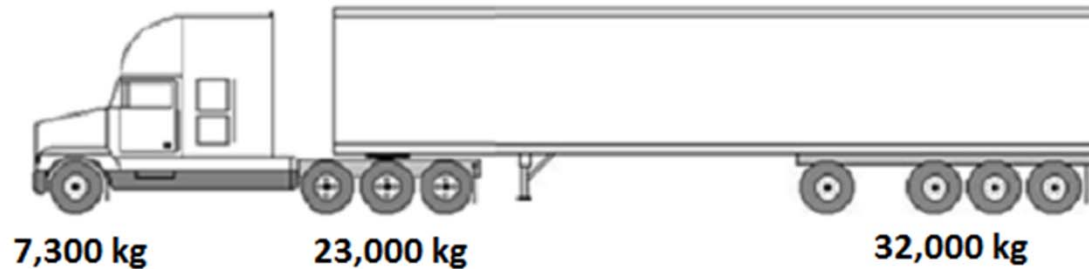
- NB Long Combination Vehicle Program:
  - 16 carriers in the program.
  - Assessing Rocky Mountain Double Configuration.



- 31 m total length.
- B-Train connection.
- Defined Routing
  - Arterial highways only.

# New Vehicle Configuration Pilot

**Tri-Drive Tractor Quadrem Axle Semi-Trailer - 62,300 kg GVW**



- Operate on Arterial Highway network.
- Subject to weight monitoring and reporting.
- Other routing can be considered with review.
- Two carriers operating under agreement.
- Other companies inquiring.
