## **Achievements 2022**


## Departmental Permit Management System (GPM)

- 2019:
  - Special Road Train Operating Permits Regulation (LCV, ≈1,200 permits)
  - Regulation respecting special permits (≈44,400 permits)



- 2022 (October 24):
  - Special permits issued under section 633 (≈12,000 permits)
     1986, 1990, 1996, 2018

In the event that a special permit cannot be issued under the *Regulation respecting special* permits or the *Special Road Train Operating Permits Regulation*, the Minister may issue a special permit by virtue of the powers conferred on her under section 633 of the *Highway Safety Code*.





# **Achievements 2022 Stinger Steer Car Carrier**




### 2023 reform:

- Vehicle Load and Size Limits Regulation 1991, 1998, 1999, 2010, 2013
   90% of modifications were authorized by permits 633.
- Special Road Train Operating Permits Regulation 1987, 1999, 2005, 2014, 2019
   Lift axles are still not allowed.

### 2024 reform:

Regulation respecting special permits 1990, 1993, 1999, 2010, 2019



#### Service Areas

Rest Areas with food and gas services in addition to services typically provided at rest areas.



#### Lookouts

#### Rest Areas

These areas provide services including washrooms and a picnic area, and are either permanent or seasonal (open from mid-May to mid-October).



#### Truckers' Rest Areas
