Regulatory Updates

- All changes to the National MOU have been updated in our Vehicle Regulations with the exception of:
 - Wide based single tires are permitted to operate at parity to traditional dual tires for the Island portion of NL only.
 - A permit is required
 - There have been no requests for permits at this time

Weighscale Bypass Program

- As of November 8, 2023 Drivewyze Pre-Clear is available at all weighscale locations
- This bypass program is expected to:
 - Reduce congestion at weighscale facilities
 - Allow inspectors to focus on carriers with a history of non-compliance
 - Increase efficiency for carriers

Portable Weighscale

- As of March 2024 we have added low speed weigh in motion to our fleet of portable scales
- This new system will speed up the weighing process when officers are performing weighing operations roadside.

60 ft Semitrailers/Container Chassis

- No requests have been received for operation

Electronic Logging Devices

- As of December 1, 2023, provincial carriers required ELD's to be installed in Commercial Vehicles.
- This does not apply to vehicles that travel within 160km radius of their home terminal, return home each night to start a minimum of 8 hours of off duty time and whc's carrier keeps a record of the cycle they followed and on duty hours for each day
- Other exemptions include school buses and vehicles owned and operated on behalf of a public utility

Pilot project CBPPL

- Started a pilot project with Corner Brook Pulp And Paper Limited To allow additional weight on B-trains and self steer Quad axles



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
